

## Senior Secondary Outcomes (including Post School Destinations) – Data Dictionary

Tab	Field Name	Description
Common	Calendar Year	The year to which the data relates.
Common	ACARA SML ID	Unique ID allocated to a given school by ACARA.
Common	AGE ID	The Australian Government Department of Education ID.
Common	School Name	The official name of the school.
Common	Suburb	The suburb in which the school is located.
Common	State	The state in which the school is located.
Common	Postcode	The postcode of the school's location.
Common	School Sector	The sector that the school belongs to (Government, Catholic or Independent).
Common	School Type	The type of school (Primary, Secondary, Combined or Special). For multi-campus schools, school type is derived from individual school types of all campuses.
Common	Campus Type	The campus type of the school: School Single Entity - A school that only has one campus/site School Head Campus - This is the main campus of a school that has multiple campuses.
Common	Rolled Reporting Description	This field refers to the way in which a school's data is reported on My School: Individual Reporting - All single entity schools will be Individual Reporting. Rolled Reporting - All schools with multiple campuses will be Rolled Reporting and reported against the head campus only.
Senior Secondary Outcomes	Senior Secondary Certificates Awarded	The number of students at the school who left at the end of the calendar year having fulfilled the requirements for a senior secondary certificate issued by a Board of Studies in the relevant state or territory.
Senior Secondary Outcomes	Completed Senior Secondary School	The number of students at the school who left at the end of the calendar year having completed the equivalent of two or more years post Year 10 studies (not necessarily full-time nor consecutive) who are eligible for a statement of results, or a record of achievements.
Post School Destinations	Students at University	The proportion of students graduating from the school in the calendar year who gained university placements. This data is only available for selected schools in Victoria, Queensland, Western Australia and the Australian Capital Territory.
Post School Destinations	Students at TAFE	The proportion of students graduating from the school in the calendar year who engaged in TAFE/vocational study. This data is only available for selected schools in Victoria, Queensland, Western Australia and the Australian Capital Territory.
Post School Destinations	Students in Employment	The proportion of students graduating from the school in the calendar year who commenced employment. This data is only available for selected schools in Victoria, Queensland, Western Australia and the Australian Capital Territory.
